TEAM MEMBER SUPPORT

65001 CHE Team Member Assistance (formerly The Employee Assistance Fund)

Supported solely by We Give Campaign gifts, this fund lends a helping hand to team members at a time of financial need resulting from a personal crisis or catastrophic event. Available to both part-time and full-time team members in good standing, all inquiries and assistance are provided confidentially.

81098 CHE Team Member Scholarships and Education

CLINICAL PROGRAMS & SERVICES

81004 CHE Alzheimer's

Supports training for staff, capital and minor equipment, renovations and patients and family support.

65043 CHE Center for Mindfulness

Support for the center will help it expand services and support in helping our care providers effectively manage stress and improve mental health. Efforts will be focused on mindfulness-based stress reduction, to reduce physical and psychological suffering while building resilience, balance and peace of mind. Funds raised will help cover operational costs, staffing and program support to reach additional team members and patients.

65020 CHE Endocrine Center - Diabetes, Obesity, Research

PATIENT SUPPORT

66607 CHE Adult Outpatient Speech Pathology - Royal Oak

Provides treatment scholarships for patients to continue speech and language rehabilitation.

66723 CHE Animal-Assisted Therapy

Supports the Animal-Assisted Therapy program at Beaumont Children's administered by the hospital's certified child life specialists. The program helps hundreds of young patients each year cope with the stress and anxiety of hospitalization through interactions with furry, four-legged volunteers. The therapy is a goal-directed intervention designed to improve human physical, social, emotional, and/or cognitive functioning.

65003 CHE Bridge to Hospice Program

Supports our palliative consultation program for patients that are hospice criteria appropriate but wish to continue with their curative care. These patients have advanced illnesses and are being transitioned

to hospice. The focus of the program has been to offer free, community-based services staffed by home health aides that support the philosophy of maintaining patients in their home.

81066 CHE Cancer Center Patient Care - Farmington Hills

Assists with health-related expenses not covered by insurance or other programs.

81067 CHE Cancer Programs - Dearborn

Supports enhancing patient care including purchasing equipment, programs, patient needs and continuing education of staff of the cancer programs.

64705 CHE Grosse Pointe Spiritual Care Fund

Scholarships are also provided for qualified needy patients.

67301 CHE Petrovich SRNA Scholarships/Education Fund
