

Helen DeVos Children's Hospital FAQ

1) How many beds are there in the children's hospital?

The children's hospital is 14 floors totaling 440,000 square feet and has 244 beds.

2) How many children's hospitals are there across the country

Helen DeVos Children's Hospital is one of 60 children's hospital across our nation.

3) How many specialty services are available?

Helen DeVos Children's Hospital offers expert care from more than 300 pediatric providers, in more than 50 services and programs, and 2,000 team members that focus on the health of children in our community.

4) What year did the big blue building open?

The building opened on January 11, 2011. Prior to the opening, children's services were in the center tower of Butterworth Hospital.

5) How much was raised for the capital campaign?

The Foundation's goal was to raise \$100M for the new children's hospital. In the end the community support totaled \$103M from over 6,000 donors.

6) How many children are seen each year?

In 2022, there were 95,595 total visits. Of those total visits 86,959 were outpatient and 7,636 were inpatient.

7) How is HDVCH rank amongst other children's hospitals?

We are ranked nationally by U.S. News & World Report in cancer, neurology and neurosurgery.
