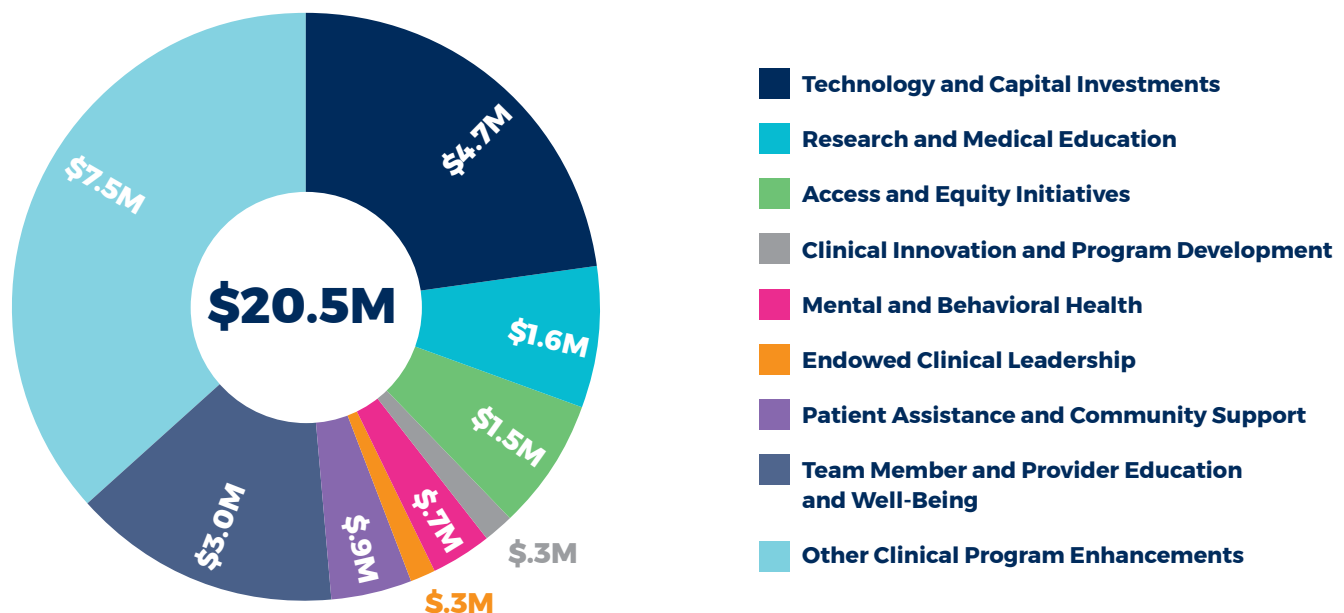

**One hundred percent** of gifts to the Corewell Health Foundation Southeast Michigan go to the areas designated by our donors. In 2025, **\$20.5 million** in philanthropic funding was distributed to support patient care programs, leading-edge technology, new care spaces and other vital initiatives shown below – all designed to ensure the best, most advanced care experiences possible for patients and families.



# Fundraising Highlights



Longtime donors **Don and Mary Kosch** gave gifts totaling \$7 million to Corewell Health Children's to support the establishment of the Donald Kosch Pediatric Emergency Center at Corewell Health Dearborn Hospital and the Center for Exceptional Families endowment fund.



More than \$4.9 million in grants were awarded by the **Michigan Department of Health and Human Services** to support the Corewell Health teen health centers in Southeast Michigan, providing valuable medical and behavioral health services to thousands of young people in underserved communities.



**Jim and Patti Anderson** gave \$6 million to create a vascular interventional radiology lab, invest in surgical equipment and technology, and support advanced surgical technology and training at Corewell Health Beaumont Grosse Pointe Hospital.



The **Respiratory Foundation of Southeast Michigan** continued a long history of partnership and support with grants totaling more than \$820,000 for the acquisition of advanced respiratory equipment for the advancement of exceptional respiratory care at eight hospitals.



## NATIONALLY RECOGNIZED

Your generosity provides the support our clinicians need to innovate and ensure excellence in all they do. Because of that, we are nationally recognized for excellence.

### High-Quality Clinical Care

Three of the top five hospitals in Michigan are Corewell Health hospitals, including our William Beaumont University Hospital (#2) and Corewell Health Beaumont Troy Hospital (#4), according to U.S. News and World Report. Nine medical specialties are also nationally ranked, and more than 100 received high-performing ratings.

### Nursing Excellence

Corewell Health has the most Magnet-designated hospitals in the state, including seven hospitals in Southeast Michigan. Magnet is the highest international distinction for nursing excellence.

### Patient Quality and Safety

Six Corewell Health hospitals received A ratings from The Leapfrog Group, including Grosse Pointe, Troy and Trenton, and seven received B ratings, including Farmington Hills. No health system with hospitals in Michigan had more A or B ratings than Corewell Health.

## Your Support Changes Lives: One Patient's Story

Amanda had a long history with breast cancer – many family members, including her mother, faced the disease. And in fall 2023, after regular and thorough screening, she was diagnosed with invasive ductal carcinoma and began receiving care at Corewell Health.

In addition to her physical care, which included surgery, chemotherapy and radiation, Amanda also received guidance and support from the donor-supported Wilson Cancer Resource Center at Corewell Health Beaumont Troy Hospital. There, she joined a breast cancer support group and took part in other monthly therapeutic activities.

**"I would not have navigated my day-to-day cancer treatment journey as well had it not been for many programs and resources offered through Corewell Health," Amanda said.**

The Wilson Cancer Resource Center team was with Amanda every step of her journey. The day she rang the bell, signifying her completion of radiation treatment, she discovered four team members from the center standing alongside her family and care team to cheer her on. "Their dedication and support overwhelmed me beyond words. I am so thankful to Corewell Health, from the bottom of my heart," she said.
